

BOOKING CONDITIONS

1. BOOKING

- a) By booking online and paying a 25% deposit you reserve a place on your course subject to confirmation that the course will go ahead. If there are insufficient people to enable the course to go ahead then your deposit will be returned. Do NOT make travel arrangements until the course is confirmed.
- b) Once a course is confirmed you will be notified by phone and email and full payment will be required not less then four weeks prior to the commencement of the course.

c) Late Booking

Booking made within 4 weeks of the courses commencement must be confirmed with Pyrennique before payment is made and then full payment must be made within forty eight hours of a phone and or email confirmation.

The Client should complete and sign the booking form and return it together with payment of the initial non-refundable deposit (25% of the total due). Following receipt of the booking form and deposit Pyrennique.com will send a confirmation invoice and statement. This is the formal acceptance of the booking.

2. PAYMENT

The balance of the total due is payable not less than eight weeks before the start of the course. If payment is not received by the due date Pyrennique.com reserve the right to give notice in writing that the booking is cancelled and retain the deposit.

Bookings made within eight weeks of the start of the photography course require full payment at the time of booking.

3. CANCELLATION

- a) In the event of a cancellation by the Client after the courses has been confirmed by phone and or email, this must be received in writing or email by Pyrennique. com. The date of receipt of the cancellation by Pyrennique.com will determine the amount of the total cost which will be refunded to the Client:
- 56-42 days before course start date 50%; 41-15 days before course start date 25%; 14 days or less before course start date 0%.
- b) In the event of a cancellation by Pyrennique.com this will be made in writing and will be followed within 7 days by a total refund of all amounts paid by the Client to Pyrennique.com (unless cancellation is made under the circumstances stated in Clause 2) and will be given in the events of either Force Majeure when it will be immediate or due to underbooking (ie minimum number of bookings to make the course viable is not reached) when it will be not less than 28 days before the course start date.

4. TRAVEL

Do NOT make travel arangements until the course is confimed. The Client is responsible for all UK travel and flight bookings to and from the Course location and therefore:

- a) a Client arriving or departing on flights different from those stated at the time of booking will be responsible for his or her own transfer costs or additional travel expenses
- b) Pyrennique.com is not responsible for any expenses loss or other damage caused to the client by the acts or omissions of the carrier or delay or interruption of travel services for any reason whatsoever
- c) as Pyrennique.com is not party to any flight bookings or other travel arrangements made by the Client and has received no payment for the same Pyrennique.com will not refund the costs of any flight bookings or travel arrangements in the event of cancellation pursuant to Clauses 2 or 3.

5. DOCUMENTATION

The Client must possess a valid passport and all visas permits and certificates including medical certificatesrequired for the journey and hereby accepts responsibility for the same.

6. INSURANCE

The Client will obtain the appropriate travel insurance cover before the departure date which must cover all loss expenses and damages arising from, including but not limited to, the cancellation of the course (whether in whole or in part) personal accident and injury, medical and repatriation costs, loss of baggage and personal money and belongings and flight cancellations and delays.

7. CHANGES

As the course is also designed as a holiday it requires flexibility and Pyrennique.com reserves the right to alter the cost services or other particulars but will advise the Client of any material changes (in advance if possible) and the Client accepts that these and the draft itinerary and course details are proposals to which Pyrennique.com will endeavour to adhere or improve but without a specific contractual obligation so to do.

8. DISCLAIMER

Pyrennique.com disclaims any responsibility or liability for the death injury or illness of the client unless arising directly from the negligent act or admission of Pyrennique.com and the Client hereby accepts this disclaimer and thereby signifies that he or she hereby releases Pyrennique. com and its principals agents employees and associates from all liability costs claims actions and demands arising directly or indirectly out of his or her participation in the course.

9. This contract shall be governed by English Law in every particular, including formation and interpretation and shall be deemed to have been made in England. Any proceedings arising out of or in connection with this contract may be brought in any court of competent jurisdiction in England
